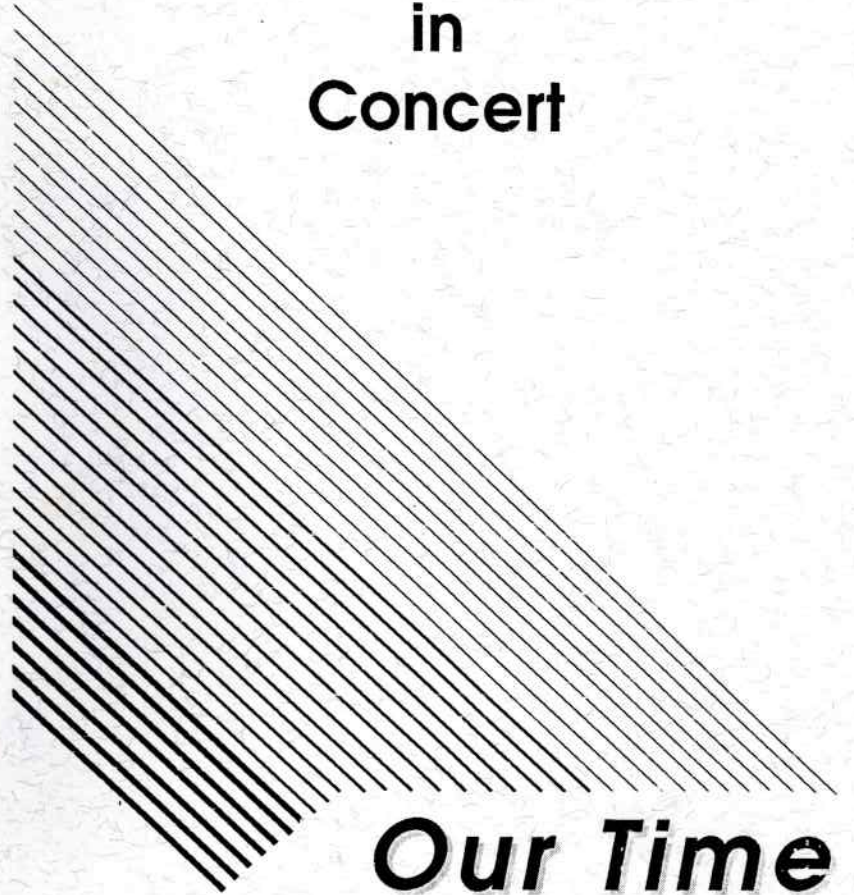

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THE MONTROSE SINGERS

The Montrose Singers is Houston's gay men's chorus. Since their premier performance on June 6, 1980, at the Tower Theater in Houston's artist colony, they have given eloquent voice to music which addresses issues of human rights. Their repertory boasts music from 11th century England and the Levant during the Crusades, Renaissance madrigals and motets, standard classics of prominent composers, barbershop favorites, Broadway and pop hits, contemporary country western songs, and selections written especially for the group.

The Montrose Singers is a long-standing member of GALA (Gay And Lesbian Association of) Choruses, a network of ensembles throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia, and South Africa.

The Montrose Singers performed in "Texas Sing Out," a statewide concert for the 1991 March on Austin for Lesbian and Gay Rights; and have proudly performed in both national tours of the phenomenally successful AIDS benefit, "Heart Strings." They have also produced concerts and performed benefits in Houston's Jones Hall for the Performing Arts, The Wortham Center, Alley Theater, University of Houston's Cullen Theater, Rothko Chapel, Autry House, and in the Plaza of Nations in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada.

The Montrose Singers' next performance will be at GALA Festival IV in Denver, Colorado, on Monday, June 29, in Boettcher Hall and Temple Buell Hall.

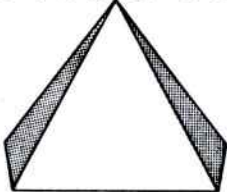




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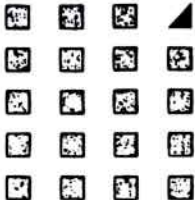

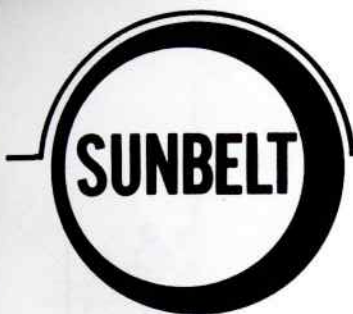
